TOWN OF LIBERTY ORDINANCE # 2020-01

AMENDMENT TO ORDINANCE 2.01 DRIVEWAY/FIRE NUMBER ORDINANCE

WHEREAS, the Town of Liberty Driveway Ordinance 2.01 was adopted 5/18/1999 and;

WHEREAS, the costs to the town have increased and the ordinance fees have not been increased since adoption of the original ordinance and;

WHEREAS, a fire number is required on all roads public or private that have structures.

NOW THEREFORE, the Town Board of Supervisors of the Town of Liberty, does ordain as follows:

Section 1 – Title/Purpose

This ordinance will now be entitled the Town of Liberty Driveway/Fire Number Ordinance and include a fire number permit as part of the Driveway permit procedure.

Section 3 – General Provisions

Item F has added if a driveway exists serving agricultural land without improvements and a building permit is applied for, section E will apply for the structure and the driveway will need to be brought up to applicable standards within.

Section 4 – Procedure and Fees

The Driveway permit fee is increased to \$100.00. 2/5 of this established fee (\$40.00) will be paid to the Town Officer who performs the inspection and the other 3/5 (\$60.00) will be retained in the Town's General Fund to cover the other costs of materials and administration. Any subsequent sign will be billed at \$60.00 per sign.

Approval of alleged existing driveway without a fire number fee is \$100.00. This includes on-site inspection of alleged driveway and if it is determined the driveway does not meet specifications it must be brought into compliance with a final site inspection and approval.

Approval of a driveway on private land fee is \$160.00 with the second fire sign billed to the owner. This includes initial on-site consultation, any interim inspections or consultations and a final site inspection and approval.

Approval of additional dwellings on private land fee is \$160.00 with the second fire sign billed to the owner. This includes initial on-site consultation, any interim inspections or consultations and final site inspection and approval.

Should any section or provisions of this ordinance be declared invalid, such decisions shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this ordinance.

Section 6 – Effective Date

This ordinance shall take effect from and after its passage and posting as provided by law.
